The Kitsap County Planning Commission has completed its review of the proposed Kitsap County 2016-2036 Comprehensive Plan and associated Development Code, Environmental Impact Statement, Capital Facilities Plan

The findings and recommendations of the planning commission will now go forward to the Department of Community Development and the Board of County Commissioners. The procedures of the planning commission call for the submission of a minority report if there is significant disagreement among the planning commissioners.

The Majority of the Planning Commission favored large changes to staff recommendations of reasonable measures intended to encourage future population growth in the urban areas of Kitsap. The changes that the Planning Commission approved severely limit the effectiveness of the proposed reasonable measures.
